5. Guidelines and criteria for submitting applications for workspaces in the Startup Labs

Incoming applications will be ranked on a first-come, first-served basis and evaluated according to the criteria listed in the application form. If there is any uncertainty regarding applicants' technical requirements or the availability of laboratory workspaces is limited, the candidates will be contacted in order to ensure that any deviations from the requirements described in the application are acceptable to the user.

Applications that have been provisionally rejected due to limited availability of laboratory workspaces will be placed on a waiting list. Applicants will be informed of this and notified as soon as free workspaces are available. In these cases, applicants may also, in consultation with the lab management, reduce their requirements to the minimum in order to be admitted to the Startup Labs.

Submitting an application for laboratory workspaces does not entitle the applicant to a space. Workspaces are allocated on the basis of availability at the discretion of the Vienna Business Agency, within the framework of the criteria defined by the Vienna Business Agency, and no claims whatsoever against the Agency will be accepted in the event an application is not approved.

Annex I – Parties eligible for application

Existing companies and companies in the process of being established in Vienna are eligible to apply.

Existing companies must meet the following conditions:

- They must either be headquartered in Vienna or have a permanent establishment in Vienna by the start of the project at the latest,
- the value-adding activities of the project must be carried out predominantly in their permanent establishment in Vienna, and
- they are a small⁵ enterprise with a permanent establishment and/or research facility in Vienna and a maximum 25% participation of a large enterprise.

Enterprises in the process of being established must be

- established six months after starting use of the Startup Labs and
- meet the requirements of an eligible existing company after establishment.

Micro-enterprise:	< ten employees and (annual turnover ≤ two million euros or annual balance sheet total ≤ two million euros)
Small enterprise:	< 50 employees and (annual turnover ≤ ten two million euros or annual balance sheet total ≤ ten million euros)
Medium-sized enterprise:	< 250 employees and (annual turnover ≤ 50 million euros or annual balance sheet total ≤ 43 million euros)
Large Enterprise:	≥ 250 employees or (annual turnover > 50 million euros AND annual balance sheet total > 43 million euros)
